Club Policy

- ◆ Dogs are welcome on the walks but some areas (e.g., Bolton Abbey, Boulsworth) do not allow dogs. They should be kept under control at all times so that everyone enjoys the walk.
- ◆ Walks may have to be changed due to weather or other circumstances. In very bad weather walks may be cancelled. Leaders that are unable to take their own walk will secure a replacement leader.
- ◆ We encourage car sharing from the meeting point and have a sensible fixed contribution (based on distance) for the drivers' expenses. Ask at the meeting point if you're concerned about these costs.
- ◆ Any member wishing to break away from the walk should inform the walk leader before doing so.

All sporting and leisure activities have inherent hazards associated with them and rambling is no exception. In spite of the safety of members always being the paramount concern accidents will occasionally occur. 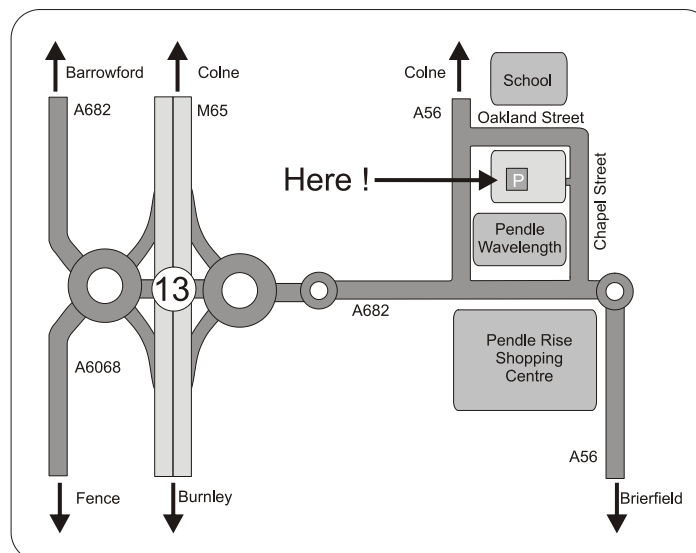
There is no need to contact us before walking with the club (just turn up at the meeting point !) but if you need further information or help then just call one of the people below.

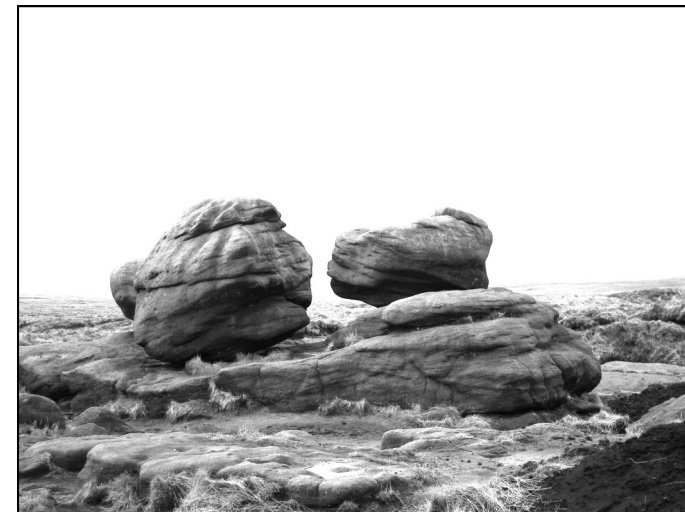
Finding Us
